## **BACKGROUND**

In the summer of 2017 the municipality was the recipient of a \$120,000.00 grant from the Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling (OMCC) Program operated by the Ministry of Transportation Ontario (MTO).

The project selected is the upgrading of chips and dust trail from Head St. through to Victoria St to asphalt.

## **COMMENTS**

The upgrading of this trail from chips and dust to asphalt will provide greater flexibility for the end user, and allow for winter maintenance.

Just as recently as the week of March 10, staff had to assist a person in a wheel chair who became stuck due to the saturated trail, which prompted the Municipality to remind members of the public to avoid the trails due to their condition.

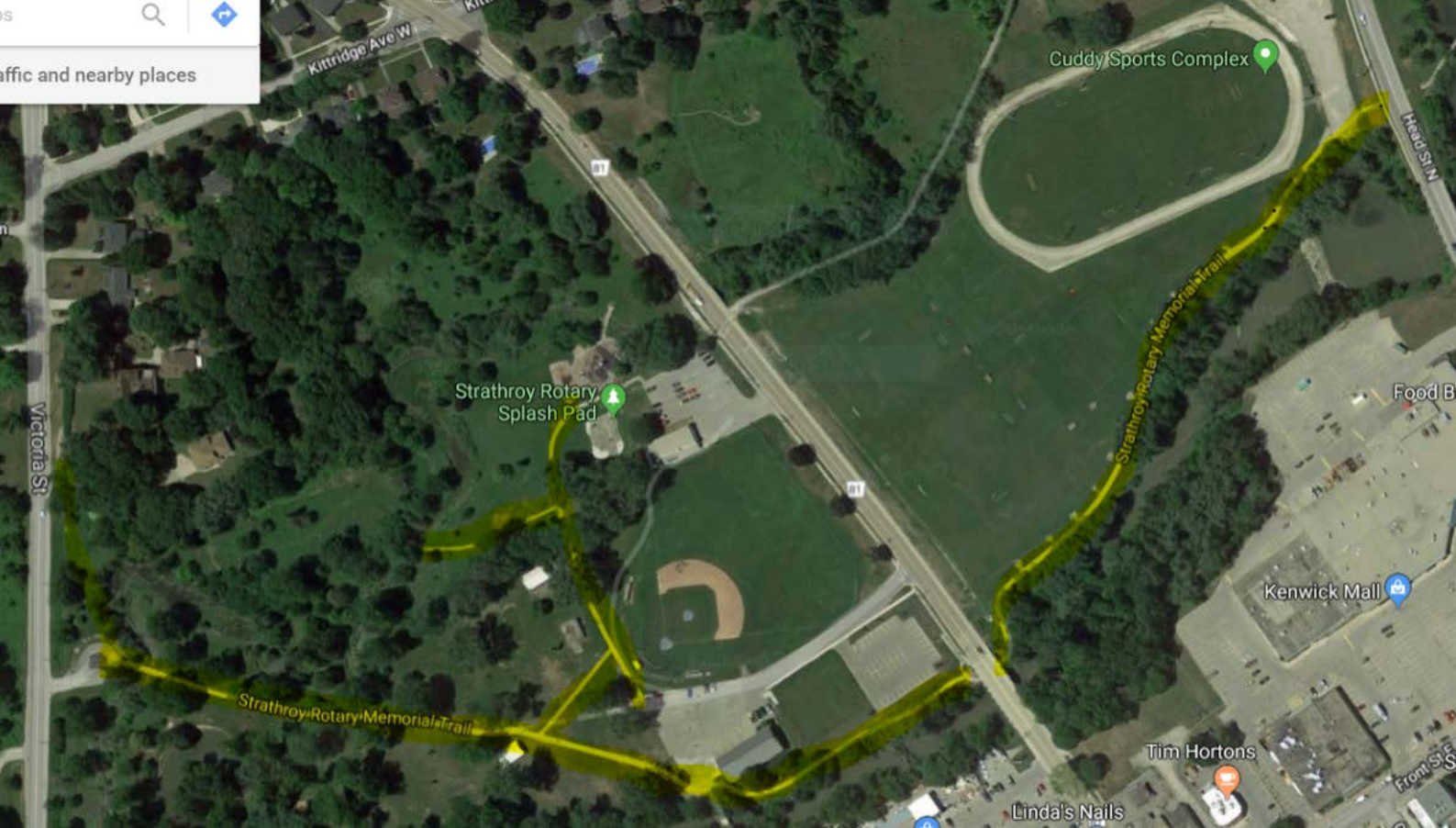
