



**Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc
Notice to Residents and Property Owners
Regarding Noxious Weeds**

The main purpose of the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990, is to reduce the impact of noxious weeds on the industries of agriculture and horticulture. Primarily this Act applies to agricultural and horticultural lands that generate income or other benefits to agriculture; this excludes lawns, gardens and private areas for personal enjoyment and leisure.

Under the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter W.5 Section 3, 16 and 23, you are requested to destroy all noxious weeds on your property.

In Urban Areas

Section 3, 13, 16 and 18 do not apply to noxious weeds or weed seeds that are far enough away from any land used for agricultural or horticultural purposes, as they do not interfere with that use.

All properties within the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc are hereby requested to be in compliance with the Weed Control Act by the **15th day of April, 2019** and throughout the growing season.

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF STRATHROY-CARADOC

BYLAW NO. 23-19

BEING A BYLAW TO APPOINT A WEED INSPECTOR FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF STRATHROY-CARADOC FOR THE YEARS 2019 TO 2022

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc deems it expedient to appoint a Weed Inspector for the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF STRATHROY-CARADOC AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** Mark Brown, County of Middlesex Weed Inspector, is hereby appointed as Weed Inspector for the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc for the years 2019 to 2022;
2. **THAT** the said County of Middlesex Weed Inspector may carry out his duties as set out in The Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990 and amendments thereto;
3. **THAT** after publication of the notice to property owners to destroy weeds in a newspaper having the general circulation in the Municipality, the Council is hereby directing the Weed Inspector to cause noxious weeds or weed seeds to be destroyed in the prescribed manner on all or part of any lot shown on a registered plan of subdivision and on lots not exceeding ten acres that are not shown on such a plan in accordance with Section 16 of The weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990;
4. **THAT** the Weed Inspector shall report to the Clerk of the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc the amount of the expenses incurred by him in the discharge of his duties under Section 16 of The Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990 with respect to each parcel of land concerned and the Clerk shall place on the Collector's Roll of the Municipality the amount so expended against the respective parcels concerned and such amounts shall be collected in the same manner as taxes collected under The Municipal Act, 2001;
5. **THAT** all Bylaws or resolutions contrary hereto are hereby repealed.

Read a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 15th day of April, 2019.
